

# SEMINAR ON RECOUNTING HORRORS OF KUPWARA MASSACRE

The Department of International Relations, University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir in

collaboration with Legal Forum for Kashmir (LFK) Islamabad organized a seminar titled "Recounting Horrors of Kupwara Massacre & Testimonial Report Launch of Kupwara Massacre" in Education Hall, Chehla Campus on January 27, 2023. Ms. Carin Fischer, who is an expert on Kashmir and advocating for the rights of Kashmiris in the United States, joined the seminar through Zoom and unveiled the genocide horrors committed by the Indian forces in Occupied territory. It is worth mentioning here that Ms. Fischer spent a decade in the held valley and shared first-hand experience in the seminar.

In his opening remarks Dr. Mehmood Hussain, Head of the Department of International Relations UAJK, welcomed the honorable guests and other participants at the seminar and delivered a brief speech, which highlighted the significance of Kashmir for Pakistan.

Ms. Saba Aslam Executive Director, of Islamabad Institute of Conflict Resolution, and Mr. Nasir Qadri Executive Director, of Legal Forum for Kashmir in their speeches threw light on the Kashmir dispute from a legal perspective and urged the students to play their active role in highlighting the Indian atrocities on Kashmiri people and the Kashmir conflict in its true perspective at international fora.

During the seminar, the students of the seventh semester of the IR Department Inam Ali Naqvi, Khansa Shah, Soma Aslam, and Abu Huraira presented their research papers on different dimensions of the Kashmir issue.

Ms. Madiha Shakil (Lecturer) moderated the session, which was attended by a large number of students and Faculty members of the Department.

At conclusion of the seminar, the IR-UAJK and LFK expressed resolve to continue to strengthen institutional engagement to produce research and joint activities to internationalize the Kashmir Issue.


