Activities from July 2021 to December 2021

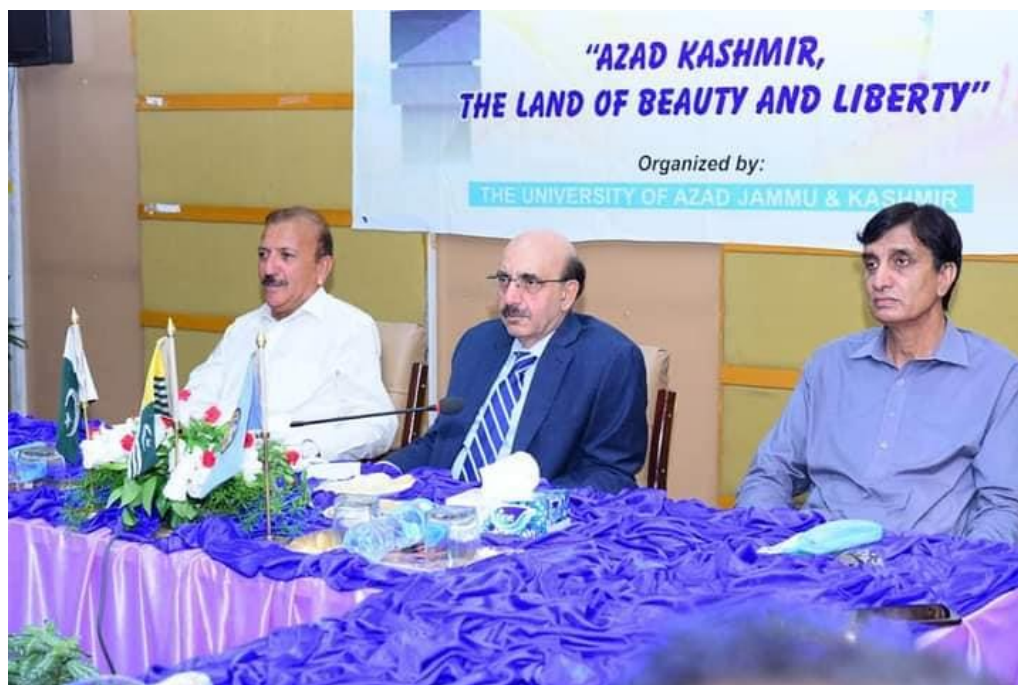
