RULES FOR DECLAMATION CONTEST

- A speaker will speak for a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 minutes. Marks will be deducted for failing to observe the stipulated time limit.
- Any speaker making offensive or derogatory remarks about any important personage or institution and passing controversial religious, political or sectarian remarks shall be disqualified immediately.
- The speakers will be assessed on the basis of content matter of their speech, delivery of the content, their proficiency and command over the language, the response of the audience and overall impact of their stage presence.
- Paper reading is not allowed.
- Speakers should refrain from using excessive Urdu words in their English speeches and vice versa.
- One best speaker for each language Urdu and English will be awarded with Shield and Certificate. Whereas other participants will be awarded with certificates of participation only.
- The decision of the judges will be final and undisputable.
